For Golf Cart Operation
Off Golf Courses

Q- What kind of equipment do I need on my golf cart?

- You must have proper brakes, steering, tires, red reflectors on front and back, and a rearview mirror.

Q- Are there any other laws I should be aware of while operating my golf cart?

- Yes, you must still obey traffic laws while operating golf carts. You must yield to pedestrians when on sidewalks.

Q - Can I drive to dinner?

- Be careful with this, DUI laws pertain to golf carts.

Q - Can golf carts be operated on sidewalks?

- Yes, as long as the sidewalk is at least 8' wide.

Q - Is there is a speed limit on the sidewalk?

- Yes, 15 MPH is the limit, Violations are treated the same as in a vehicle.

Q - How old do I have to be to drive a golf cart?

- You must be at least 14 years old

Q - Do I have to have a special driver's license?

- No license is required

Q- Can I use my golf cart on the road?

- Only where signs permit in golf course communities.

Q - Does my golf cart need any special equipment?

- If you are operating after sunset, you need proper headlights, brake lights, turn signals, and windshield.

Q - How many people can I have on my golf cart?

- It varies, but no more than it was designed for.
